Proclamation of Moisture safety– prize

This prize has been founded by the Moisture Research Centre at Lund University, which was reorganized and strengthened in 2000 from the Moisture Research Group in Lund. Today, several departments at Lund University and the Swedish National Testing and Research Institute (SP) are active members of the centre. The Moisture Research Centre is working with both fundamental and applied research about moisture safety in buildings and is also active in the spreading of information concerning moisture related processes in buildings.

The prize will be given to a person or persons that have influenced the building process for projects in the Nordic countries that fulfil the following requirements:

- Moisture safety in design, construction and administration with concern to energy efficiency and environmental aspects
- Showed good long-term performance during operation

Who can receive the prize?

Purchasers, architects, constructors, designers, contractors, material suppliers, administrators or people whom have contributed to projects that fulfil the requirements are all eligible.

The winner will be invited to the conference, "Building Physics in the Nordic Countries," which will be held in Reykjavik 13-15 June 2005.
